Sub:- Fund Flow Mechanism under Supplementary Nutrition Programme for 2014-15

Madam/Sir,

A new fund flow mechanism under Supplementary Nutrition Programme has been put in place from 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter of 2014-15 for direct transfer of funds by DSWOs at the district level to the joint account of AWWs and the account of WSHGs engaged in THR manufacturing. It has now come to the notice of the Department that some districts are facing difficulties in coping with the increased workload on account of this due to shortage of manpower in DSWO office. In order to overcome such difficulties, the following steps may be taken.

- 1. If required, DSWOs may hire services of one Data Entry Operator for five days in a month up to March,2015 on daily wage basis as per the rate fixed by Labour & ESI Department. Expenditure on this score can be met out of office contingency.
- 2. Funds required for morning snacks and hot cooked meal for a quarter should be transferred to the joint account of AWWs in advance. The claim as per SOE received from the CDPOs shall be adjusted in the subsequent quarter.
