Background:

- v. To create an inclusive & joyful stimulating environment at home facilitated by skilled care givers for holistic development of a child

AWWs are required to publicize the event in the community and ensure participation of children, care-givers, members of the community, Janch & Mother Committee and SHG members.

- v. Adolescent boys and girls are welcome to participate and helps parents and care givers during their activities

Roles and Responsibilities:

- v. CDPO/Supervisors to invite the block level, panchayat level officials to attend the programme and will attend and facilitate to organize the event.
- v. AWWs will arrange some waste material to develop interesting toys and display during the Child Fest.
- v. AWWs will decorate the centre/venue to make it colorful with colourful paper/leaf made flags, jhotis etc.
- v. AWWs to prepare a list of participants and mobilize all participants to attend the programme on the designated day.
- v. AWWs will prepare the activity detail and activity wise participant list for the event

Monitoring & Supervision:

- v. Concerned supervisor needs to visit at least AWCs under her respective project ahead of the event. She has to observe the preparation session and give suggestion to the AWWs for further improvement if required.

Reporting:

- v. The Sector Supervisor will submit the report along with photographs of the event in the prescribed format to the CDPO after the completion of the activity. CDPOs are required to compile all the reports for the project for further submission to DSWO in the format attached with the note. The report for the District will be compiled by the DSWO and will be submitted to the Department.

Budget:

- v. Rs 500/- per AWC will be provided under Child Fest. The amount is to be utilized for organizing the event at AWC level and for procurement of refreshment for participants.
