Sub:-Guidelines for Construction of Anganwadi Centre under MGNREGA through convergence.

Madam/Sir,

The detailed guidelines for construction of Anganwadi Centre under MGNREGA through convergence with funds of W & CD Department was issued under joint signature of Commissioner-cum-Secretary, Panchayati Raj Department and Commissioner-cum-Secretary, W & CD Department vide P.R Department letter no. 13158 dated 07-05-2013. As per the said guidelines, out of the unit cost of Rs. 5.00 lakh for construction of each AWC Building, Rs. 2.25 lakh was to be booked under MGNREGA and the rest Rs. 2.75 lakh was to be booked under funds allotted by W & CD Department. Accordingly, the target for construction of AWC Building for 2013-14 and 2014-15 was communicated to all the Districts and the required funds for 2013-14 and 2014-15 was released to all the Districts by the W & CD Department.

Further, for the year 2015-16, it was decided that only the unskilled wage component of the unit cost of Rs. 5.00 lakh is to be booked under MGNREGS and the rest is to be booked out of the funds of W & CD Department. In other words, Rs. 50,000/- is to be booked under MGNREGS and balance Rs. 4,50,000/- is to be booked out of the funds of W & CD Department for construction of each AWC in convergence mode.

In this regard, detailed guidelines was issued vide W & CD Department letter no. 11552 dated 14-07-2015. Accordingly, the target for construction of AWC Building for 2015-16 was communicated to all the Districts and the required funds for 2015-16 was released to all the Districts by the W & CD Department.

But, it is a matter of serious concern that out of the total target of 6306 for construction of AWC Building for the year 2015-16 (spill over projects for 2013-14 & 2014-15 and new projects for 2015-16), only 1552 nos. of AWC Buildings have been taken up and 62 nos. of AWC Buildings have been completed as on 30-11-2015. The status of district wise AWC Buildings through convergence as on 30-11-2015 is enclosed herewith.

It has been brought to our notice that due to enhancement of the wage rate and cost of the material, the AWC Buildings are not being able to be completed within the unit cost of Rs. 5.00 lakh. Further, the internal wiring of the AWC Buildings should be included within the estimated cost. Therefore, it is decided that for completion of all the AWC Buildings taken up through convergence from 2013-14 to 2015-16, the balance amount required beyond Rs. 5.00 lakh as per approved plan will be met from MGNREGS.

The cost of the toilet and water supply facilities for each AWC Building should be met from CFC/SFC fund. The water supply facility includes provision of overhead tank, tap connection to kitchen and toilet of AWC Building, sinking of tube well wherever necessary and installation of pump set for lifting of water to overhead tank.

The child friendly green fencing around the AWCs should also be taken up from MGNREGS fund.

Hence, all the AWC Buildings as per the target for 2013-14 to 2015-16 should be taken up by 31st December, 2015 and completed by 31st March, 2016 positively. This should be monitored regularly. This should be also an agenda for monthly review meeting by the Collector/PD DRDA at District level.

This should be taken as extremely urgent.
